HAZARDOUS MATERIALS and FIREARMS POLICY

Per R400.9415 (2):

I/We agree to store all hazardous materials to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all family members and all foster/adoptive children placed in my/our home.

I/We agree that all medications (prescriptions and over the counter) are securely locked and I/we will show the locked location of the medication to the licensing worker.

Per Rule R400.9415(3): Unless carried in the home as permitted by law, firearms and ammunition must be stored as follows:

- (a) Firearms must be all of the following:
 - (i) Locked in compliance with 1 of the following:
 - (A) By a cable-lock.
 - (B) By a trigger-lock.
 - (C) In a gun safe.
 - (D) A solid metal gun case.
 - (E) A solid wood gun case.
 - (ii) Unloaded.
 - (iii) Separate from ammunition.
 - (iv) Inaccessible to children.
- (b) Ammunition must be stored in a locked location and inaccessible to children.

I/We recognize that FSCA requires its worker see a copy of a gun permit for all guns. By signing below, I/we acknowledge that I/we have received a copy of and agree to follow FSCA's Knife and Gun Policy.

- The family has shown a copy of the gun permit to the worker for each handgun owned.
- The family has shown the worker the location of any ammunition (arrows) and the worker verifies it is locked.
- The family has shown the worker the locked location of any firearms (including BB gun, bow & arrow, hunting tools etc.) including those that do not require permits.
- The family does not own any firearms.

It is the expectation of the agency that all foster/adoptive parents certified or borrowed through Family Service & Children's Aid comply with this policy. By signing below, I/we agree to abide by the terms and conditions outlined above.
